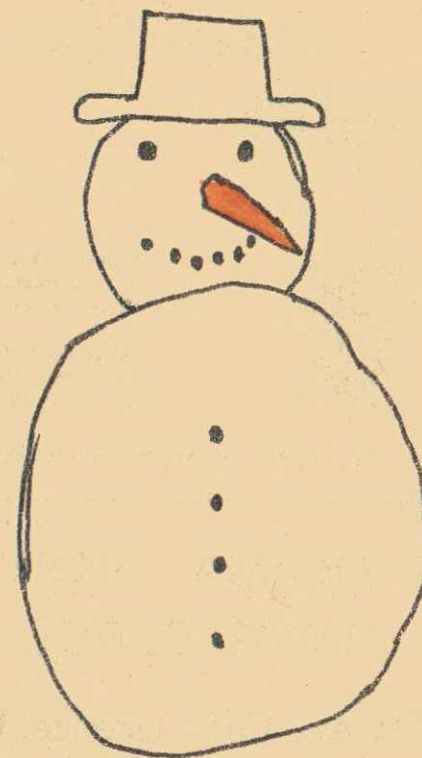

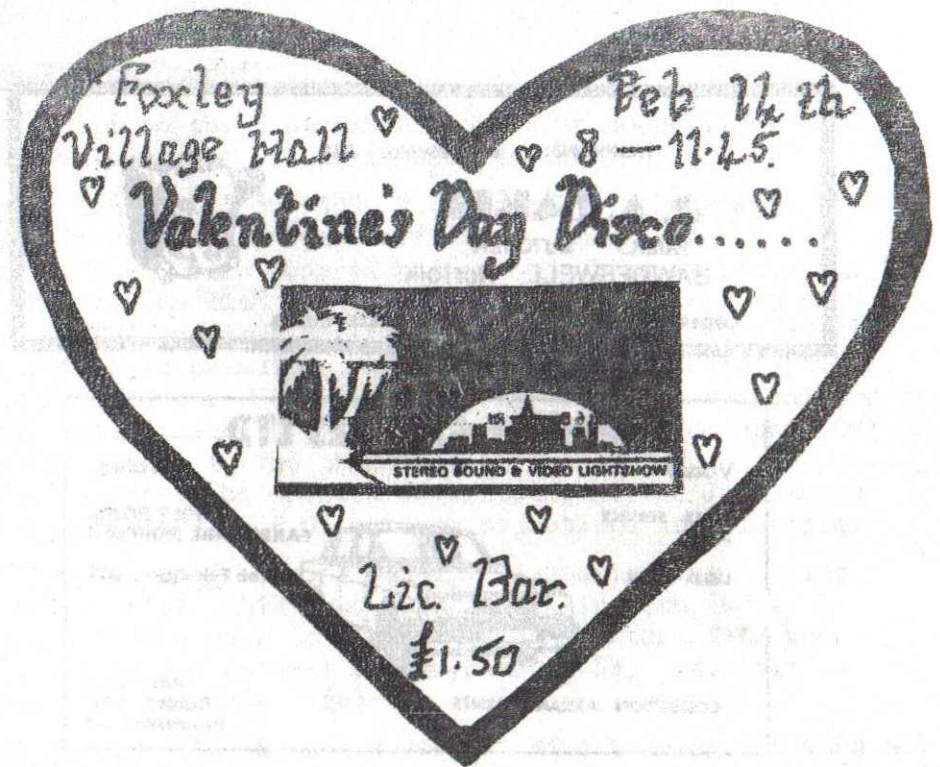

Meeting held on the 5 December 1985, four councillors and one parishioner, Mr Don Davis were present.

Planning App. No. 3/85/1325 Floranova Ltd. Provision of 5 Portacabin buildings, temp. office accommodation.  
Observation - Parish Council had no objection in principle with the proviso that all future buildings be kept to one storey. The previous application for a bungalow, 3/85/0823, no objection in principle, subject to Agricultural/Horticult. Exclusion Licence. P.C. is extremely concerned re road safety on this fast stretch of the A 1067, and wish to be consulted regarding access to the proposed site.  
 3/85/1467 Sign to be erected advertising Silver Jubilee at Foxley Nurseries. P.C. have no objections in principle.

Old Surveyors Land Parish Council is considering working the remainder of this land (other part is occupied by D. Webster), with a view to opening it as a Nature Walk for all lovers of the natural countryside. The pond will be investigated and made safe.

School Report The School Governor, Miss M. Joice has informed Parish Council of the appointment of the New Headmaster for Bawdeswell Primary School. Mr J. Cox takes up his appointment in the new year and we wish him every success. Holy Communion - a revised order of Service

At Bawdeswell we will be changing to the Alternative Service Book Rite 'A' Order of Service on those occasions when at present we have been using the pale - green covered "Series 3" Service. The first occasion will be at the 10.30am Service on Sunday 26th January. The Rite 'A' Service is very similar in content to series 3 because it is the final revision of the latter which was prepared after careful consultation with parishes throughout Britain, prior to the publication of the Alternative Service Book in 1980.

Rite 'A' has more alternatives, for example, a choice of four Eucharistic Prayers. However, page numbers will be announced, and the Parochial Church Council feel sure that worshippers will soon become familiar with the Red Booklets as they did with the Green ones.

The change is necessary because Series 3 Holy Communion ceases to be authorised for use in the Church of England after the 31st December 1985. A similar change will probably be made at Foxley in due course.
