

- 1. The owners of the garage are hoping to receive planning approval to move to a new site on the b'-pass: this is still being considered by the authorities. If successful they will be willing to sell the present garage site for housing development, we shall also be free to do so.
- There is a proposal to sell our sites
  to an association for development of
  starter homes, irrespective of the sale
  of the garage. This is under discussion
  with the planning authorities at present.




