

As May was the anniversary of our taking over the hall, first year maintenance has now been carried out on requisite equipment and fittings. At the last Trustees meeting as well as the regular subjects we discussed revised Terms and Conditions for hirers of the Hall and agreed donations for the car park and driveway. We also spent time discussing the first year report for the Lottery which is in the process of being written and marketing ideas to attract more day time bookings.





Recycling plea!

Since October 2015, as part of its kerbside recycling scheme, Norfolk County Council has allowed householders to put glass in their grey bins. However this is having a dramatic effect on the amount of glass recycled from the glass bank and income is down over 50%. As reported last month £443.08 was received this year in recycling credits. £286.12 from glass and £156.96 from textiles.

The income from the recycling banks is ring fenced for the sole purpose of awarding community grants. The decrease in income from the glass bank means the Parish Council will be restricted in the grant/s they are able to offer to local groups, as the money received from glass recycling goes back into the community by way of grant awards.

Whilst it is easier for residents to put glass in their grey bin, there is no financial benefit to Bawdeswell in doing so. Using the glass banks is a small thing that everyone can do to support the local community.

Residents are encouraged to support both the glass and the textile bank too as this also generates an income, which is used in the same way as the glass recycling credits. The banks are situated next to the Village Hall so easily accessible.

The Parish Council would like to remind local groups/organisations that grant applications must be received by the 26th August for consideration at the Council's September meeting. Applications to be forwarded to the Clerk at the contact details below.


