### Bawdeswell: A Local Service Centre - Yes or No?

Firstly I'd like to thank all the Parishioners who took the time and trouble to send in their comments to the Breckland Planning website regarding the Two Fields Way development. Of the 37 comments, only one was in favour of the development. At the planning meeting on 25th July, only one of the Planning Committee voted against the application - the rest were in favour. This showed a total disregard for the views of those most affected by their decision - i.e. the people of Bawdeswell.

Even more disgraceful in my view, was that the Parish Council had to limit its verbal objections at the meeting to a total of 3 minutes. Similarly the parishioners were also only permitted a total of 3 minutes. Not each - but a total for the whole village.

Most planning decisions do not go to the Planning Committee and we had to enlist the help of District Councillor Gordon Bambridge to make sure it did. Our objections were overruled and we cannot appeal the decision.

The fight we must now take on is to stop Bawdeswell becoming a Local Service Centre (LSC). When Breckland Council first suggested that Bawdeswell become an LSC, they allocated us a total of 35 dwellings for future years. However, this has already been increased to 50.

In designating us an LSC, Breckland are saying we have an infrastructure within the village to sustain large scale development. The reality of the situation is that we have no public transport to anywhere other than Norwich or Fakenham. We have no Doctor's Surgeries in the village and no public transport to get to the surgeries elsewhere. There are little or no employment opportunities in the village and our one school is already full to capacity. Becoming a LSC will open the floodgates for local landowners to submit further development plans. For example, already there has been an offer made to Breckland to make land available close to our Village Hall for a development of 60 dwellings.

We are not the only village objecting to LSC status and if we do not fight against it Breckland will assume that there are no objections from the people of Bawdeswell. We cannot allow this to happen. Remember the Parish Council objection counts as a single vote. The more objections from Parishioners, the bigger the impact.

Bawdeswell Parish Council is committed to accepting only small scale development within the 'Settlement Boundary' and the Council now urges you to send in your objections or views on our being designated an LSC.

### Bawdeswell Village Hall



We have had our first meeting after the summer break, and what a lovely break it has been.

The afternoon café has been run at the hall throughout the school holidays. A big thank you is due to all the volunteers who gave up summer afternoons to keep the hall open for those using the field and play area. THANK YOU.

There was a lot of business to catch up on after the longest break between meetings we have had for several years!

Omnis, the contractor, spent 2+ weeks at the hall in August completing the final outstanding snag items at the end of the one year warranty period. We appreciate their attention to detail in undertaking this work and leaving the building in good order. The car park and driveway refurbishment has also been completed by the Parish Council during the summer and it looks great. We just have to remember that the speed limit remains at 5mph!

Also during August the Cinema Club received another grant of 50 chairs from the BFI. We are enormously grateful for this. We now have 50 comfortable matching chairs and are selling off some of the old black plastic ones. In time we want to increase the number of good chairs we have but will not be so lucky again. We will have to buy them ourselves and are saving up.

The first Lottery Year End Report was submitted at the end of July. New Terms and Conditions of hire have been produced and are available on the website. Insurance coverage was discussed at the meeting. Our insurance covers any claims due to building malfunctions, but any activities undertaken in the hall by hirers where an accident is possible should be covered by the hirer. The new hall is continuing to cover its costs.

### Book Club

"Sons and Lovers" by D H Lawrence



This book is a wonderful depiction of ordinary working class life from the inside in the early twentieth century. As one of our members commented, 'you could almost smell the coal fire blazing in the fire grate and feel the grime of this coal mining town'.

No writer before or since has written so well about the intimacies enforced by a tightly knit mining community and by a family where feelings are never hidden for long. When the marriage of Walter Morel and his sensitive and high minded wife begins to break down, the bitterness of their frustration seeps into their children's lives. Gertrude is grief stricken by the sudden early death of their first, and her favourite son, William, and is only shaken from this debilitating grief by the near death of her second son, Paul. Her subsequent total immersion into Paul's life could seem in modern times to be almost abusive. Lawrence's powerful description of Paul's subsequent struggle to define himself sexually and emotionally through relationships with two women - the innocent, old fashioned Miriam Leivers and the experienced, provocatively modern Clara Dawes - make this a novel as much for the beginning to the twenty first century as it was for the beginning of the twentieth.

The discussion of the book engendered a good deal of comment indicating an almost universal enjoyment of Lawrence's ability to engage and involve the reader in the depiction of life in that time.

*The Book Club meets in the Workhouse Bar on the first Thursday of every month at 8pm. We mostly obtain books from the library so there is not the expense of buying new books each month. 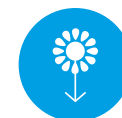

#### Recreation Ground Car Park

The work on the car park and driveway refurbishment has nearly been completed. It is understood that the surface will have to settle before car parking spaces can be marked out. The Parish Council are looking to put hedging around the edge to prevent vehicles driving onto the grass and ruining the new drains. Already, a survey of the car park following a heavy rain shower showed that there was no signs of water where previously the car park would only have been suitable for ducks and fishermen!

#### Other Matters

The Council had no objection or comment to make with regards to the planning application for a two storey rear extension, linked entrance at Rose Cottage, Dereham Road. This application has since been withdrawn.

Although Breckland planning committee approved the development of 36 dwellings on the Two Fields Way site, it is subject to conditions and no approval notice has yet been received. The Parish Council agreed to write to Breckland requesting ownership of the two proposed amenity areas with financial provision for maintenance to ensure that these areas are not developed in the future.

#### Local Plan

District Councillor G. Bambridge gave an update on matters at Breckland including the topic of devolution (for which Breckland have opted out of consultation) and the local plan, where Bawdeswell has been proposed for Local Service Centre status, which has been approved as a consultation document. There will be a consultation period where views would be sought prior to submission to the planning inspector. The PC and individuals are encouraged to respond.

#### Section 106

The Council formulated a list of potential projects which could then be costed and submitted to Breckland DC for future 106 section funding. Suggestions included the

1. Apologies for absence: Bill Borrett
2. There were no declarations of Interest by Council Members in items on the agenda and any applications for dispensation.
3. The minutes of the meeting held on 19th May 2016 were approved and signed.
4. Progress on items from the last meeting, not on this agenda.
  - 4.1 Litter Pick – this was successful with 14 residents taking part, including some not normally involved in village affairs, 18 bags of litter were collected and efficiently removed by Breckland Council. There was general disquiet about the amount of litter especially in the lay-bys off the A1067. It was agreed that to deter others someone would need to be caught and prosecuted for fly tipping in that area. JH asked if there could be a national ‘Keep Britain Tidy’ scheme but GB felt that the best way to educate the public was via the litter picking initiatives.
  - 4.2 Transparency code – laptop has been purchased and website training for clerk arranged for 11/08/16
  - 4.3 Mazars- Annual return has been certified as complete. A fee of £120 has been levied.
  - 4.4 Dog – This is not such a problem at the moment.
5. Planning matters
  - 5.1 Planning application: Old Rectory Cottage, Old Fakenham Rd – Approved
  - 5.2 Breckland Local Plan: Outcome of meeting 15th July 2016. GB summarised the position at the moment. Foxley has less than the 3 specified amenities and it is therefore proposed that it should be classed as a PD05B village. This would mean that there would be no development boundary and the area would be regarded as open countryside in which only small developments could take place and only with local support. This should protect the village from excessive development but allow for some smaller housing schemes e.g. infilling within present housing developments.
- 6 Bus stop and bus shelter: clerk reported that she has made no progress in contacting the right people at the council. GB to ask Bill Borrett who to contact. Once it has been determined what, if anything, could be altered clerk to seek the opinion of bus users in the village.
