#### **Book Club**

"Notes from an Exhibition" by Patrick Gale



Opening with her death while painting obsessively in her studio in Penzance, the exhibition of the title refers to a posthumous retrospective of work by extraordinary but troubled artist Rachel Kelly. 'Notes' provide brief chapter headings, summaries of some of her remarkable paintings and other personal artefacts which are also on show.



Through this device the reader is introduced non-chronologically to events in her life. We piece together for ourselves the dramatic mystery of her past as the stories of her family unfold, discovering in the process the extent to which the notes interpret her intriguing character. It is not until the final chapters that the mystery is resolved, and most of us found this successful in making us want to read on; those who were revisiting the novel agreed to appreciating it even more second time round, and there was some illuminating discussion of the final twist to the plot.

Rachel is bipolar, alternately delighting and terrifying her four children and devoted, patient Quaker husband Antony. Rescued from Oxford when pregnant and suicidal, Rachel is supported by his tolerant kindness and finds security in his childhood home. Gale portrays Rachel's condition convincingly, drawing on his own relationship with a fellow sufferer, and he explores its impact on her creativity and on her family, for whom she is a capricious and ultimately self-absorbed presence.

Generally, we thought that the attempts by her children to understand their mother were described with psychological astuteness: although Rachel is portrayed as a pretty unsympathetic character, the reader is invited to empathise with her family.

Discussion of the adult relationships in the novel raised some controversy. Some felt that Gale had worked to include plot strands which could seem superfluous. Some of the coincidences were felt to be rather far-fetched; but on the whole this was a novel which we agreed we had enjoyed – not necessarily a regular occurrence!

The Book Club meets in the Workhouse Bar on the first Thursday of every month at 8pm. We mostly obtain books from the library so there is not the expense of buying new books each month. We are currently reading "Waterland" by Graham Swift for discussion at our meeting on 3rd August and will read "The Essex Serpent" by Sarah Perry for discussion at our meeting on 7th September. 



## "In The Footsteps of Mallory & Irvine"

Roger Smith - Fellow of the Roual Geographical Society

#### Tickets £10

It is astonishing to witness the achievements made in the 1920's as expedition parties made their way through Tibet towards their ultimate goal - the summit of Everest. This lecture by Roger Smith tells the story of a 2009 party he led travelling from Katmandu into Tibet on its way up to the summit of Lhakpa Ri (7030m) and to Everest's North Col. It followed the same path as those early pioneers and camps at the same locations. So much has changed over the years and yet at first hand so little seems new. The people, the landscapes and the harsh environment are the same as ever but the equipment, technical support, local politics and nature of visitors has changed.

George Herbert Leigh Mallory (18 June 1886 - 8 or 9 June 1924) was an English mountaineer who took part in the first three British expeditions to Mount Everest in the early 1920s. During the 1924 British Mount Everest expedition, Mallory and his climbing partner Andrew "Sandy" Irvine (8 April 1902 – 8 June 1924) both disappeared on the North-East ridge during their attempt to make the first ascent of the world's highest mountain. The pair were last seen when they were about 800 vertical feet (245 m) from the summit. Mallory's ultimate fate was unknown for 75 years, until his body was discovered on 1 May 1999 by an expedition that had set out to search for the climbers' remains. Whether Mallory and Irvine reached the summit before they died remains a subject of speculation and continuing research. However, the photograph of his wife Ruth which he had vowed to leave on the summit was not found on his body so? The search for Irvine's body continues as he may have a camera with photos that could settle the controversy.





The Deanery Synod met in All Saints Church at the end of June, after a Communion Service followed by coffee and refreshments provided by Sandi Taylor - thank you. We were introduced to the Revd Andrew Beane, Rector of Aylsham, who is to be Rural Dean of the soon to be combined Sparham and Ingworth Deaneries.

Bawdeswell held a routine PCC Meeting in July and one of the topics was the 15% increase in Parish Share for 2018, requested of all the churches in Heart of Norfolk Benefice "to meet the true cost of two clergy posts and our share of Ministry in the Diocese". This came as a bit of a shock because in the previous F.L.E.B.B.S. Benefice we were thanked year after year for paying our share in full, and were rewarded with much smaller and occasionally zero annual increases. To raise an extra 15% in the coming year puts us in a very uncomfortable position as all this money comes from direct giving and not fundraising.

You will have read in the last Reeve's Tale that Foxley are contemplating asking the Diocesan Churches Trust to take over their church. We were asked if we could help in any way by adopting St Thomas' church, but sadly we are not in a position to take on that responsibility. The Friends of Bawdeswell Church do a very noble job in fundraising for the upkeep of our church building and we could not ask them to do more.

We hope soon to have the exterior of the church windows painted and some repairs to the oak spire. For this we thank the Friends in anticipation of their support.

In September the Friends of the Church are organising a Flower Festival. Full details elsewhere in the magazine. We look forward to seeing you there hoping that you will pop in and enjoy the floral creations on the Heart of Norfolk theme.

#### **Letter from Sally**

Dear Friends,

August, I find, offers an opportunity to take stock and then to do some forwardplanning. We are in the School Summer holiday, of course, and there are fewer meetings as many people are away.


