

RON AND OLIVE MERCER

During the last few years, Bawdeswell has lost residents who were real characters as well as assets to the village. Some were lost through Covid, some due to severe illness and others to old age.

We will not list them all, just the most recent, Ron and Olive Mercer.

Olive was born in 1926 and died in November 2020. Ron was unable to attend Olive's funeral as he was very ill in the Norfolk & Norwich Hospital. She lived all 94 years of her life in Bawdeswell. Olive was part of the Bugdale family and her grandfather was a licensee of The Black Horse public house in Bawdeswell. She had a wicked sense of humour, always a smile on her face and willing to help those who needed it. Like many other Bawdeswell ladies she was a 'land girl' during WW2. Both Ron and Olive had fantastic memories and were a massive help in the compiling of our village heritage.

Ron was born in Sutton, Surrey in 1925. He died in the Norfolk and Norwich Hospital on 15th January 2021.

He grew up in Sutton and then joined the Royal Navy at a very young age. He saw active service in WW2 and whilst serving in the Navy he would often use his leave to visit his grandparents who lived in 'The Old Harness Makers' in Bawdeswell. It was during such a visit that he met Olive at a Bawdeswell dance and they were married 2 years later in 1946 in Foxley Church, the Bawdeswell church having been destroyed during WW2.

On leaving the Navy, he took up an apprenticeship as a carpenter and joiner. He soon became expert in both and was also a very skilful wood carver. Many have praised his skills in carpentry when working in local houses and village halls. Ron was also a very good artist. His paintings were incredible.

Ron always said what he thought, so you always knew where you were with him. However, the one person who could smooth his ruffled feathers was the love of his life Olive. They were inseparable and a perfect example of wedded bliss. Ron would have hated being apart from Olive. Now two months after Olive's passing, they will be together again.

Jackie and I were fortunate to become very good friends of Ron and Olive and like their daughter Linda and granddaughter Kerry, we will miss them terribly as will everyone who knew them.

They will also be missed by a grateful village who know how much Ron and Olive contributed to it.

An officer with a speed gun recently monitored vehicles on the Reepham Road and Norwich Road. It was acknowledged that speeding was an issue in most villages and the Council were limited in what further action could be taken. Residents are encouraged to report incidences of speeding to the Police.

Drainage Village Hall car parking area

As the flooding in the car parking area at the Village Hall is severe and restricting access to the children's play area, the Council agreed to continue with plans to install pipework to drain excess water into the nearby field. Further enquiries will be made in an effort to obtain further quotes.

Other matters

Work to move the parish noticeboard has been delayed due to current restrictions and will be carried out as soon as possible. The Council agreed in principle to reinstate the Boundary of the Church / Saxon Meadow. A quote had been received for a post and rail fence to be installed the full length of the boundary.

Norfolk Wildlife Trust sent a report on Adams Pit. As no further action in the next couple of months was recommended, any decisions with regards to the future maintenance of Adams Pit could be deferred to another meeting.

Church Letter

Dear Friends,

You may remember the book *Silent Spring* by Rachel Carson (USA), published way back in 1962. The book focused on the adverse environmental effects caused by the indiscriminate use of pesticides. It was massively influential on US environmental policy, leading ultimately to a nationwide ban on DDT for agricultural uses and the creation of the US Environmental Protection Agency.

I first came across *Silent Spring* whilst living in Devon during the Foot & Mouth outbreak among cattle in 2001. Nationwide, over 6 million cows and sheep were killed in the eventually successful attempt to halt the disease. The farms in Devon were certainly locked-down and silent that Spring and for much of the year.

I am not a scientist, but what we are living through with COVID-19 feels very much like 2001, although the casualties are now our fellow human beings, with the appalling statistics we hear on a daily basis. Some of those 'statistics' are our friends and loved-ones; we grieve their loss and pray for their eternal rest.

The thread which seems to run through both awful episodes seems to rest on how we care for the environment. In the rush for greater efficiency, have governments and businesses the world over enabled nature to become distorted, destabilising the balance of creation?

Locally, the church community in the Heart of Norfolk Group is exploring how we can make our church buildings and churchyards more ecologically sustainable, with a target across the Church of England to become net-zero carbon by 2030.

There is a project called "Caring for God's acre" which supports groups caring for churchyards and burial grounds, encouraging refuge space for native wildlife. But we also need to start thinking about our church buildings – particularly the use of energy for heating and lighting. If you would like to contribute towards this work, we'd love to hear from you.
