runs approx hourly from 0820-2330\*.  
The last bus home leaves at 2035.

only, 0950 at the bus stop in The  
Street, Bawdeswell.

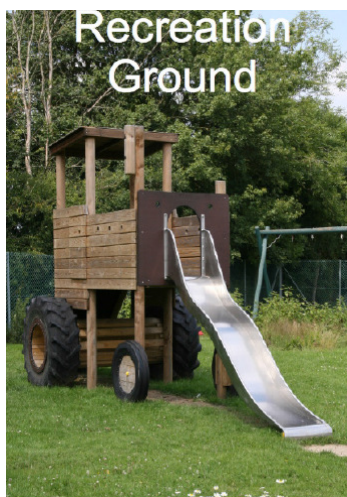
